Day 51: Romans 15:1-3

- Listen to the Word: Pay attention to the call to bear with the failings of the weak, following Christ's example.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate how bearing with others' weaknesses reflects Christ's love.
- Fellowship in the Word: Engage in discussions about the challenges and rewards of bearing with one another's weaknesses.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone facing challenges by sharing verses on bearing with one another in love.

Day 52: Romans 15:4-6

- Listen to the Word: Reflect on the encouragement and hope found in Scripture and the call for unity.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the role of Scripture in providing hope and fostering unity.
- Fellowship in the Word: Discuss with others the ways Scripture has provided encouragement and strengthened unity in your lives.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone going through a difficult time by sharing verses that bring hope and emphasize the importance of unity.

Day 53: Romans 15:7-13

- Listen to the Word: Focus on the call to welcome one another as Christ has welcomed
 us.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the importance of extending Christ-like welcome to others.
- Fellowship in the Word: Share personal stories of experiencing or providing Christ-like welcome.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone feeling isolated by emphasizing the inclusive nature of Christ's welcome.

Day 54: Romans 15:14-16

- Listen to the Word: Reflect on Paul's affirmation of the Roman believers' goodness and the sanctifying work of the Holy Spirit.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the role of the Holy Spirit in sanctification and how goodness reflects His work.
- Fellowship in the Word: Discuss with others the transformative power of the Holy Spirit and how it shapes goodness in believers.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone struggling with personal growth by sharing verses on the Holy Spirit's sanctifying work.

Day 55: Romans 15:17-21

Day 56: Romans 15:22-29

- Listen to the Word: Reflect on Paul's desire to visit Rome and his commitment to preach Christ where He has not been named.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the importance of personal commitment to spread the gospel and the impact of Paul's ministry.
- Fellowship in the Word: Share personal stories of commitment to spread the gospel and discuss the challenges and joys of such endeavours.

- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone going through a challenging time by sharing verses on the comfort and strength found in prayer.

Day 58: Romans 16:1-2

- Listen to the Word: Reflect on the commendation of Phoebe and her service to the church.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the significance of recognizing and commending individuals who faithfully serve the church.
- Fellowship in the Word: Discuss with others the impact of acknowledging and appreciating the contributions of fellow believers.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone who serves faithfully in your community, sharing verses that affirm the value of their service.

Day 59: Romans 16:3-16

- Listen to the Word: Pay attention to the list of individuals Paul greets and commends for their service.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the sense of community and collaboration among believers as reflected in Paul's greetings.
- Fellowship in the Word: Discuss with others the importance of community and the diverse roles within the body of believers.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone in your community by sharing verses that highlight the beauty of diverse contributions to the church.

Day 60: Romans 16:17-20

- Listen to the Word: Reflect on Paul's warning about divisive individuals and the promise of God crushing Satan.
- Investigate the Word: Investigate the importance of guarding against division within the church and trusting in God's ultimate victory.
- Fellowship in the Word: Discuss with others the challenges of maintaining unity and the reassurance found in God's power. Highlight the sense of community, collaboration, and the importance of guarding against division within the church.
- Encourage with the Word: Encourage someone to actively promote unity and trust in God's victory over divisive forces, sharing verses that emphasize both concepts.
